If your child intends to participate in equine activities (any activities at camp involving horses, ponies, mules, donkeys or hinnies), the enrolling parent(s)/guardian(s) must sign this form and return it to Camp Ketcha with the registration forms. **NO CHILD WILL BE ALLOWED TO RIDE WITHOUT A SIGNED COPY OF THIS FORM ON FILE AT CAMP KETCHA.**

I understand that there are inherent risks in equine activities including but not limited to:

1. The propensity of equine to behave in ways that may result in damages to property or injury, harm or death to persons on or around the equine. Such equine behavior includes, but is not limited to bucking, shying, kicking, running, biting, stumbling, rearing, falling and stepping on.
2. The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movements, and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals.
3. Certain hazards such as surface or subsurface conditions of the ground.
4. Collision with other equines or objects.
5. Unpredictable or erratic action by others relating to equine behavior.

The undersigned assumes these inherent risks. The undersigned participant understands that he/she is solely responsible for knowing the range of their ability to manage, care for, and control a particular equine and has the duty to act within their own ability, to maintain control of the equine, to heed all warnings and to refrain from acting in a manner that may cause or contribute to the injury of any person or the damage to any property.
